Animal and Food Science

Bob talked mainly about the support that his department and students provide to the poultry industry on the entire Delmarva Peninsula. The poultry industry drives over 75% of the agriculture business in Delaware and Maryland eastern shore. In 2010 the State of Delaware alone produced 559,000,000 broilers.

Sussex County produces more meat chicken than any other county in the US, and probably the world.

Companies like Purdue will own the breeders and hatcheries. Growers will then feed and care for the birds until they are ready to be sent to the processor. Birds are sampled for disease before being shipped. The process repeats every 12 weeks or so.

UD has a small flock and also keeps some BLUE HENS. Backyard flocks are kept mainly for table eggs. To keep birds laying, the eggs must be removed after they are laid. Keeping extra light on when the days get shorter also enhances egg production.
