5-13 Bill Walters –NRA

Bill owns a small business that offers combat training and lifestyle instruction to improve personal safety. He discussed the pending legislation on gun laws:

1. Mandatory background checks. Convicts in jails were polled (for what it's worth) and they overwhelmingly said they do not get guns at shows and dealers, they get them from crime or friends or barter for drugs.
2. Reporting lost or stolen guns in 48 hours. Good rule if you check every other day.
3. No guns within 1000 feet of a school zone. Again a good idea, unless you are driving past a school on the way somewhere else
4. Ban on size of magazine..... but no limit on the number of mags, so not very effective
5. Assault weapons ban. A good idea, so do not bring home an AK 47 from Iraq if you have served overseas
